We have audited the accompanying balance sheet – modified cash basis of Penn Township, York County, Pennsylvania, as of December 31, 2020, and the related statement of revenues and expenditures – modified cash basis, debt statement – modified cash basis and statement of capital expenditures – modified cash basis for the year then ended in the format prescribed by the Department of Community and Economic Development of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting; this includes determining that the modified cash basis of accounting is an acceptable basis for the preparation of the financial statements in the circumstances. Management is also responsible for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Emphasis of Matters

The financial statements are prepared on the modified cash basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Consequently, certain revenues and related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned, and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when a liability is incurred. The accompanying annual financial report was prepared for the purpose of complying with rules and regulations of the Department of Community and Economic Development of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, does not include supporting disclosures or government-wide statements and is not intended to be a complete presentation of the Township's assets, liabilities, revenues and expenses. Our opinion is not modified with respect to these matters.

COMMENTS

Defined Contribution Plan

The Township's defined contribution pension plan is not reported as a Fiduciary Fund of the Township for reporting on the DCED report, due to the fact that the Township does not hold the assets in a fiduciary capacity.
