

PENN TOWNSHIP
FINANCE COMMITTEE
MAY 4, 2009

The Penn Township Finance Committee convened on Monday, May 4, 2009 at 7:20 PM following the Public Safety Committee meeting. Present were Chairman Heilman and Commissioners Prieber, Rewa and Felix. Commissioner Goldsmith was absent with notice. Also present were Manager Garvick, Police Chief Rhodes, Fire Chief Cromer and Administrative Assistant Rodgers. The following matters were discussed:

ANNOUNCEMENTS: None

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: The minutes of the April 6, 2009 Finance Committee meeting were approved as submitted.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS: None.

HANOVER CYCLERS: The Committee received a request dated May 4, 2009 from the Hanover Cyclers for a waiver of the permit fee for signs and a canopy to be located at Pine Creek Structures, 1025 Baltimore St., for the Race Across America, an international bicycle race. This is an annual event but the canopy was usually constructed at the Rutter's Farm Store on Baltimore Street. The Committee recommended approving the request.

TAX COLLECTOR TRAINING: The Committee received a request from the tax collector for reimbursement for the cost of a seminar. The Committee recommended approving the request with the stipulation that the next training reimbursement be from the school district.

WATER DISTRICT PENALTY: The Committee received a request from John and Muriel Crabbs for a waiver of the penalty for their 2008 Countryside Water District tax because they accidentally paid the tax to the sewer office. The Committee recommended waiving the penalty.

BOY SCOUT TROUP 110: The Committee received a request dated April 7, 2009 from Boy Scout Troup 110 for a waiver of the sign permit fee to advertise their annual mulch sale on April 19. The Committee recommended approving the request.

2009 BUDGET AND OPERATING EXPENSE REPORT: The Committee reviewed the current budget and expense report for the year. It was noted that there is a meeting scheduled for May 28 at South Western School District to meet with the York-Adams Tax Bureau about the consolidation of the Hanover Wage Tax Office in 2012.
