

Hanover Area Earned Income Tax Bureau to Close Offices

After 32 years of outstanding service to the Hanover Community, the Hanover Area Earned Income Tax Bureau (HAEITB) will officially close its offices on January 1, 2012. The new earned income tax collector for residents of the Hanover Borough, Manheim, Penn and West Manheim Townships will be the York-Adams Tax Bureau (YATB), located at 1405 N. Duke Street, York, PA 17405 (phone number – 845-1584). At that time, all records from HAEITB will be transferred to YATB including any information regarding unpaid or delinquent taxes. This change has been brought about by Act 32 of 2008 which calls for the consolidation of earned income tax collection activities into a countywide collection system. You will be receiving your 2011 personal tax forms from YATB shortly after the start of 2012 and you will file your returns with them. We are currently exploring with YATB the possibility of having someone from their office in the Hanover area to assist taxpayers with the processing of their annual earned income tax returns during the few weeks leading up to the April 15th due date. A great deal of planning has gone into preparing for this transition and we are confident that YATB will provide our citizens with the same level of outstanding service we have come to expect.
