

**ORDINANCE NO. 563**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 508 FIXING AND IMPOSING SEWER RATES AND CHARGES.**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Township of Penn, York County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

That Ordinance No. 508, Section 4, paragraph A which currently reads:

- (1) Meter rates. For properties served with water by the water supplier, sewer rents based upon water consumed as determined, by the quarterly reading of the water supplier as follows: for the quarter ending February 28, 1983, and for each quarter ending the last day of each February, May, August, and November thereafter:

QUANTITY OF WATER USED (gallons per quarter)	QUARTERLY RATES
First 7,000 or less	\$25.20 minimum
Next 18,000	\$ 1.75 per 1000 gallons
All over 25,000	\$ 1.54 per 1000 gallons

- (2) Flat rates. For properties not served with water by the water supplier, a flat quarterly sewer rent of thirty-six dollars and forty cents (36.40) per quarter for the quarter ending February 28, 1983, and for each quarter ending the last day of February, May, August, and November thereafter.

Shall be amended to read:

- (1) Meter Rates. For properties served with water by the water supplier, sewer rents based upon water consumed as determined by the quarterly reading of the water supplier as follows: for the quarter ending February 28, 2001, and for each quarter ending the last day of each February, May, August, and November thereafter:

QUANTITY OF WATER USED (gallons per quarter)	QUARTERLY RATES
First 7,000 or less	\$26.00 minimum
All over 7,000	\$ 2.00 per 1,000 gallons

2. Flat rates. For properties not served with water by the water supplier, a flat quarterly sewer rent of thirty-eight dollars and forty cents (\$38.40) per quarter for the quarter ending February 28, 2001, and for each quarter ending the last day of February, May, August, and November thereafter.
