

ORDINANCE NO. 569

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND
DIRECTING THE PAVING OF VARIOUS STREETS
AND HIGHWAYS IN PENN TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Penn Township Board of Commissioners, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that the following streets within Penn Township be constructed, reconstructed, widened, paved and/or curbed as follows:

SECTION 1:

That Karen Lane, High Rock Road, Poplar Street, Hillside Road, Meadow Lane, Lark Avenue and a proposed roadway, Industrial Drive, between Fame Avenue and Barnhart Drive, be curbed as needed, widened, constructed and/or reconstructed in accordance with applicable ordinances of Penn Township.

SECTION 2:

That the Public Works Department of Penn Township shall perform the work authorized hereby, using such outside contractors as from time to time may be required, with the materials to be purchased from the suppliers of Penn Township with the exception of Industrial Drive which work shall be performed by outside contractors through a competitive bid process using resources of the Penn Township Public Works Department as from time to time may be required.

SECTION 3:

That any trees, pipes or other materials obstructing or interfering with the free and full construction of said work shall be removed or changed by the party or parties with which the Township contracts or by direction of the Township Manager in accordance with the First Class Township Code.

SECTION 4:

That existing property owners abutting the proposed Industrial Drive roadway shall by agreement or through the application of eminent domain, grant the Township sufficient road right-of-way to allow construction of said streets and improvements.

SECTION 5:

That the cost and expense of the materials and work to be performed for the curbing and paving of the above street shall be paid by Penn Township and the same is hereby appropriated therefore out of the General Fund, Highway Aid Fund or other special account of Penn Township and that property owners abutting widened streets be assessed as allowed by law.
