

ORDINANCE NO. 592

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY,  
AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA  
APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED  
FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF THE MUNICIPAL  
GOVERNMENT, HEREINAFTER SET FORTH, DURING THE  
CURRENT YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and  
ordained by the Commissioners of Penn Township, York County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1.

That for the expense for the fiscal year of 2003, the following amounts are  
hereby appropriated from the revenues available for the current year for the  
specific purpose set forth below, which amounts are more fully itemized in the  
Budget form.
