

ORDINANCE NO. 601

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 127, VEHICLES
AND TRAFFIC, OF THE PENN TOWNSHIP CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Penn Township Board of Commissioners as follows:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 127 of the Penn Township Code is amended as follows:

127-22.1 Parking Prohibited in Specific Places

The following section shall be added to

B. Standing or Parking a vehicle:

- (4) No person shall park or leave unattended any detached trailer on or along any public street within Penn Township.

127-54 Violations and Penalties

Paragraph A - which currently reads:

- A. Unless another penalty is specifically provided for in Subsection B below, any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50) and costs of prosecution and, in the event of nonpayment of such fine and costs of prosecution, such person shall be subject to imprisonment for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.

Is hereby amended to read:

- A. Unless another penalty is specifically provided for in sub-section B below, any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of (\$25) and costs or prosecution and, in the event of non-payment of such fine and costs of prosecution, such person shall be subject to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

Paragraph B - which currently reads:

- B. Any person who shall violate any provision of a section listed below shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than that

specified for violation of said section and, in the event of non-payment of such fine and costs of prosecution, such person shall be subject to imprisonment for a period not exceeding that indicated for said section.

Is hereby amended to read:

- B. Any person who shall violate any provision of a section listed below shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than that specified for violation of said section and, in the event of non-payment of such fine and costs of prosecution, such person shall be subject to imprisonment for a period not exceeding that indicated for said section.

Paragraph C - which currently reads:

- C. A notice of violation of any provision of Article III (127-23 through 127-28) of this chapter shall be placed on the vehicle parked in violation, such notice to contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that, if he shall report to the Police Department of Penn Township and pay the penalty imposed for such violation within forty-eight (48) hours after the time of such notice, or if he shall place such sum within the envelope provided in any of the special parking fine boxes installed in various places in Penn Township within such time limit, the same shall save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine and costs above prescribed.

Is hereby amended to read:

- C. A notice of violation of any provision of Article III (127-22.1 through 127.28) of this chapter may be placed on the vehicle parked in violation, such notice to contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that, if he shall report to the police department of Penn Township and pay the penalty indicated, for such violation within ten days after the time of such notice, shall save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine and costs above prescribed.

SECTION 2.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

The articles hereby adopted shall be deemed to be incorporated into the Penn Township Code so that references to the Code shall be understood and intended to include such changes.
