

ORDINANCE NO. 804

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN,  
YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 434 ESTABLISHING THE  
COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AND  
FIXING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS  
THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Penn Township as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 434 is amended as follows:

The following shall be added to Section 2 Definitions:

“Community activities – events sponsored in whole or in part by a municipality, or conducted within a municipality and sponsored privately, which include, but are not limited to, fairs, bazaars, socials, picnics and organized sporting events that will be attended by 200 or more individuals per day. “

The following shall be added to Section 8 Mandatory Commercial and Institutional Source Separation Program:

“d. Separation of Recyclables by Commercial, Municipal and Institutional Establishments and at Community Activities:

Commercial, municipal, and institutional establishments shall separate and store, until collection, high-grade office paper, corrugated paper, aluminum cans, and other materials designated by the Municipal regulations. These establishments must arrange for the separation, collection and marketing of these recyclable materials. The establishments shall annually provide to the Municipality evidence of such arrangement, and documentation of the total number of tons recycled. High grade office paper, corrugated paper, aluminum cans, and other materials designated by the Municipal regulations must be separated for collection of all community activities. Sponsoring organizations must arrange for separation, collection and marketing of these materials. The amount of material recycled must be reported to the municipality.”

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The Articles adopted shall be deemed to be incorporated into the Penn Township Code so that reference shall be understood and intended to include such changes.
