

ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 121-4
AND ADDING SECTIONS 121-58 TO 121-59
TO THE PENN TOWNSHIP CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Penn Township Board of Commissioners
as follows:

The Penn Township Code is hereby amended by revising
§ 121-4 which establishes discounts and penalties for early
and late payment of Per Capita Taxes, and adding Article VII,
§ 121-58 and § 121-59, establishing discounts and penalties
for early and late payment of Real Estate Taxes.

Section 1.

§ 121-4. Payment schedule, which now reads:

"The said tax may be paid with a discount of two percent
(2%) until July 15, 1962, and until July 15 of each calendar
year thereafter, and may be paid at par until September 15,
1962, and until September 15 of each calendar year thereafter;
and if said tax is paid after September 15, 1962, or after
September 15 of any calendar year thereafter, a penalty of
five percent (5%) is hereby imposed thereon", is amended to
read:

"The said tax may be paid with a discount of two percent
(2%) until April 15 of each calendar year, may be paid at par
until June 15 of each calendar year, and if said tax is paid
after June 15 of any calendar year, a penalty of ten percent
(10%) is imposed thereon."

Section 2. A new Article VII, entitled "Real Estate Taxes",
is hereby added to read as follows:

§ 121-58. Real Estate Taxes.

Real Estate Taxes shall be fixed as provided for by the
First Class Township Code and collected by the Township Treasurer/
Tax Collector, as further provided for therein.

§ 121-59. Payment Schedule.

"The said tax may be paid with a discount of two percent
(2%) until April 15 of each calendar year, may be paid at par
until June 15 of each calendar year, and if said tax is paid
after June 15 of any calendar year, a penalty of ten percent
(10%) is imposed thereon."

Section 3.

It is the intent of this ordinance to establish discounts and penalties for early and late payment of Per Capita and Real Estate Taxes as authorized by the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and requested by the Board of Commissioners of York County, Pennsylvania.

Section 4.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5.

If any section, paragraph, subdivision or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately as provided by law.
