

ORDINANCE NO. 211

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE PAVING OF VARIOUS STREETS AND HIGH-
WAYS IN PENN TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING FOR
THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE COSTS OF THE SAME.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Penn Township Board of Commissioners, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that the following streets and highways within Penn Township be constructed, reconstructed, widened, and/or paved as follows:

Section 1. That Ann Street from O'Neill Avenue to Wirt Avenue, O'Neill Avenue from Baltimore Street to Baer Avenue, Baugher Drive at intersection of Granger Street, Grandview Road from Baltimore Street to the woods, Footer Street from Baltimore Street to McAllister Street, and Ruel Avenue from York Street to Blooming Grove Road be curbed as needed, widened and reconstructed in accordance with applicable ordinances of Penn Township.

Section 2. That the public works department of Penn Township shall perform the work authorized hereby, using such outside contractors as from time to time may be required, with the materials to be purchased from the suppliers of Penn Township.

Section 3. That any trees, pipes or other materials obstructing or interferring with the free and full construction of said work shall be removed or changed by the party or parties with which the Township contracts or by direction of the Township Manager in accordance with Section 2070 of the First Class Township Code.

Section 4. That the cost and expense of the materials and work to be performed for the paving of above streets and highways, excluding non-assessable work and property, intersections, engineering, supervision, and inspection costs, shall be paid by the owners of real estate bounded or abutting on said street on a foot front basis in accordance with Section 2060 of the First Class Township Code. The exclusions herein recited shall be paid by Penn Township and the same is hereby appropriated therefore out of the General Fund of Penn Township.
