

ORDINANCE NO. 219

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT, HEREINAFTER SET FORTH, DURING THE CURRENT YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Commissioners of Penn Township, York County, Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That for the expenses for the fiscal year of 1978 the following amounts are hereby appropriated from the revenues available for the current year for the specific purpose set forth below, which amounts are more fully itemized in the Budget Form.

A. General Fund
