

PENN TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
MAY 7, 2012

The Penn Township Public Safety Committee met on Monday, May 7, 2012 at 7:00 PM. Present were Chairman Prieber and Commissioners Felix, Klunk, and Heilman. Commissioner Goldsmith was absent with notice. Also present were Manager Garvick, Deputy Police Chief Laughlin, Fire Chief Cromer and Administrative Assistant Rodgers. The following items were discussed:

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Chairman Prieber announced that an executive session was held following the Health & Sanitation meeting on May 1, 2012 to discuss a personnel issue. He also announced that an executive session would be held following the Finance Committee meeting this evening to discuss personnel issues.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the April 2, 2012 Public Safety Committee meeting were approved as submitted.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: None

ACCREDITATION FEE: Deputy Police Chief Laughlin reported that the \$1000 accreditation fee was waived for Penn Township's reaccreditation for the 2012. However, for each year forward there will be a fee imposed.

NYCRPD: Deputy Police Chief Laughlin reported that the agreement for the computer programs between the Township and the Northern York County Regional Police Department is about complete.

FIRE CODE AMENDMENT: Manager Garvick reported that he would like the Board to adopt an amendment to the 2009 International Fire Code. The amendment would specify the circumstances by which the fire chief would be given authorization to conduct fire inspections. The Committee recommended approving the ordinance at the next Board of Commissioners meeting.
