The Penn Township Public Safety Committee met on Tuesday, July 5, 2011 at 7:00 PM. Present were Chairman Felix and Commissioners Prieber, Heilman and Rewa. ANNOUNCEMENTS: Commissioner Prieber read the announcement of the executive session held following the Penn Township Board of Commissioners meeting on June 20, 2011.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the June 6, 2011 Public Safety Committee meeting were approved as submitted.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: None.

NATIONAL NIGHT OUT: Chief Rhodes reported that the Penn Township Area Night Out which is sponsored by the Penn Township Police Department and York County Department of Probation will be held on Tuesday, August 2, 2011. The event will be held at the South Western School District campus from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. After the event, everyone is encouraged to return home and turn on their porch lights to show support in opposing crime in the community.

CROP WALK: The Committee received a request dated May 17, 2011 from the Hanover Area Council of Churches to conduct the annual Crop Walk on October 16, 2011. The route will be the same as it has been for the last several years. The event will start and end at South Western High School. The Committee recommended approving the request.

TRIATHOLON: Chief Rhodes reported that the proposed triathlon has been postponed until next year.

INTERN: Chief Rhodes reported that intern Steve Kimmey started last week and will be here through the end of summer. The first intern, Andrew Zimmerman, has completed his internship and did a good job.
