

PENN TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
AUGUST 3, 2015

The Penn Township Public Safety Committee met on Monday, August 3, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman Prieber and Commissioners Klunk, Felix, and Heilman. Commissioner Goldsmith was absent with notice. Also present were Police Chief Laughlin, Township Manager Rodgers, WWTP Superintendent Mahone, Township Engineer Bortner, Highway Foreman Mahan, Zoning Officer Swanner and Administrative Assistant Miller. The following items were discussed:

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Commissioner Felix announced there would be an executive session held following the Health & Sanitation Committee meeting. Commissioner Prieber read the announcement of the executive session held following the Board of Commissioners meeting on July 20, 2015.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes of the July 6, 2015 Public Safety Committee meeting were approved as submitted.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: None.

STOP SIGN ORDINANCE: Manager Rodgers reviewed ordinance No. 777 to install stop signs in the alleyway parallel to South Center Street and Brookside Avenue. The Committee recommended approving the ordinance at the next meeting even though the stop signs have been installed.

MOBILE MODEM UPGRADE: Chief Laughlin reported the modem purchased for the mobile computer in the patrol vehicle has been working as intended. He currently has budgeted to purchase another modem but requested permission to purchase four additional modems to update all of the patrol vehicles at a total cost of \$2,946. After confirming with Manager Rodgers about the current police budget, the Committee recommended approving the purchase.
