

**RESOLUTION NO. 914**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISEMENT FOR AND THE  
PUBLIC SALE OF EXCESS SEWER DEPARTMENT  
EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, Penn Township ("Township") is the owner of a 4" Barnes submersible pump, a 1997 Ford F-150 4 x 4 pickup truck and a 1981 International dump truck; and

WHEREAS, the Township purchased a 4" Barnes submersible pump, a 1997 Ford F-150 4 x 4 pick-up, and a 1981 International Dump Truck for use in the Sewer Department, and

WHEREAS, the equipment has outlived its useful life for the Township, and

WHEREAS, by virtue of §1501(II) of the First Class Township Code, the Township is authorized to convey by sale personal property where such sale is deemed to be in the best interest of the Township; and

WHEREAS, Section 1501(II) of the First Class Township Code provides that no personal property shall be sold for an amount in excess of \$1,000.00 except to the highest bidder after due notice by advertisement for bids or public auction, published one time, not less than ten (10) days prior to the date for the opening of the bids or the date of the public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that it is in its best interest to sell the 4" Barnes submersible pump, the 1997 Ford F-150 4 x 4 pick-up truck, and a 1981 International Dump Truck.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT SO RESOLVED, that the Penn Township Board of Commissioners authorizes the sale of the truck by public auction in accordance with the provisions of Section 1501 of the First Class Township Code, including, but not limited to, the advertisement of such auction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public auction shall end on September 14, 2018.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proceeds from the sale of the above-described equipment shall be deposited into the Penn Township Sewer Capital Reserve Fund.
