

ORDINANCE NO. 656

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 611,
THE SIGN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PENN, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Authority of Penn Township, York County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by the Board of Commissioners of Penn Township, it is hereby Ordained and Enacted, as follows:

SECTION 1 ARTICLE 3, PROHIBITED SIGNS

PARAGRAPH D WHICH READS: "A sign suspended between poles consisting of either pennants or spinners."

Is amended to read, "A sign suspended between poles consisting of either pennants, spinners, flags or streamers."

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, said invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
