

ORDINANCE NO. 693

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DISSOLVING THE PLUMBING BOARD, AND ABSOLVING THE POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES GRANTED TO THAT BOARD.

WHEREAS, The Penn Township Plumbing Board was created by the Board of Commissioners on March 17, 1964 for the purpose of establishing standards and procedures for the qualification and examination of master and journeymen plumbers, and authorizing the Township Secretary to issue the appropriate license to each person who meets the qualifications thereof and who passes the examination given by the board; and

WHEREAS, The Penn Township Board of Commissioners desires to approve the termination of the Plumbing Board whose duties have been assumed by the intermunicipal consortium composed of Penn Township, York City, and Springettsbury Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Penn Township hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Dissolution of Plumbing Board

The Board of Commissioners hereby dissolves and terminates the Penn Township Plumbing Board.

SECTION 2. Authority of Board of Commissioners

The Penn Township Board of Commissioners shall hereby continue with the practice of having master and journeymen plumbers test with the intermunicipal consortium.

SECTION 3. Severability

If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid, said invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed. Ordinance No. 42, Article III is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Amendment To Township Code

The Articles hereby adopted shall be deemed to be incorporated into the Penn Township Code so that reference to the Code shall be understood and intended to include such changes.
