

ORDINANCE NO. 699

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78 OF THE PENN TOWNSHIP CODE REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTS WITHIN PENN TOWNSHIP TO UTILIZE THE SERVICES OF A TOWNSHIP APPROVED WASTE AND REFUSE HAULER.

WHEREAS, the Penn Township Board of Commissioners contracts with, from time to time, a private waste hauling firm to collect and dispose of curbside trash refuse, garbage, and waste of the general population, and

WHEREAS, the contract awarded to the hauler grants exclusive collection rights, and

WHEREAS, private residential communities exist in Penn Township that independently contract refuse collection services within those communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Township of Penn, York County, PA and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1

Chapter 78 of the code of Penn Township is amended by adding the following:

§ 78-4 Garbage and refuse collection requirement

With the exception of commercial, industrial, private residential and retirement communities and facilities, all residents and small businesses in Penn Township utilizing curbside collection are required to utilize the services of the designated Township Hauler for disposal of garbage and refuse. All industries, commercial establishments and private residential and retirement communities located in Penn Township are required to designate and utilize the services of a hauler approved and licensed by Penn Township. Residents of private residential communities and retirement communities must use the hauler with whom their community contracted for the disposal of garbage and refuse.

SECTION 2.


All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
