

ORDINANCE NO. 702

PENN TOWNSHIP  
YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION BY AGREEMENT BETWEEN PENN TOWNSHIP OF YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND CONEWAGO TOWNSHIP OF ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ALONG WITH THIRD PARTY DEVELOPER, TO PROVIDE FOR INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 94 AND WILSON AVENUE; AND PROVIDING FOR SIGNAL PERMITS; MAINTENANCE, OPERATION COSTS, AND CASUALTY INSURANCE; WILSON AVENUE RIGHT OF WAY AND MAINTENANCE THEREOF; AUTHORITY OF PARTIES; AND TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT UPON ASSIGNMENT.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Penn hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. The proper officers of the Township of Penn are authorized and directed to execute and deliver an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement known as the Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. To the extent that either party requires funds to comply with the Agreement, each party shall draw from its general fund, liquid fuels fund, or such other funds as may be available for costs incurred under the Agreement.

Section 3. The Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise terminated by the parties or by operation of law.


Section 4. The conditions, purpose and objective, scope and authority delegated, extent of financing, organizational structure and manner in which personal property shall be acquired, managed and disposed of are set forth in the attached Traffic Signal and Street Right of Way Maintenance Agreement between the Township of Penn and the Township of Conewago. This Agreement is incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein, and is made a part hereof.
