

ORDINANCE NO. 703

PENN TOWNSHIP  
YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION BY AGREEMENT BETWEEN PENN TOWNSHIP AND HANOVER BOROUGH, BOTH OF YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO PROVIDE FOR DEVELOPMENT OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE 94 AND WILSON AVENUE, INTERSECTION OF WILSON AVENUE AND WEST DRIVE, AND INTERSECTION OF WILSON AVENUE AND CENTER DRIVE; AND PROVIDING FOR SIGNAL PERMITS; MAINTENANCE, OPERATION, COSTS, AND CASUALTY INSURANCE OF SIGNALS; AND STATING THE AUTHORITY OF PARTIES.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Penn hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. The proper officers of the Township of Penn are authorized and directed to execute and deliver an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement known as the Traffic Signal and Street Right of Way Maintenance Agreement, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. To the extent that either party requires funds to comply with the Agreement, each party shall draw from its general fund, liquid fuels fund, or such other funds available for costs incurred under the Agreement.

Section 3. The Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise terminated by the parties or by operation of law.

Section 4. The conditions, purpose and objective, scope and authority delegated, extent of financing, organizational structure and manner in which personal property shall be acquired, managed and disposed of are set forth in the attached Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement between the Township of Penn and the Borough of Hanover. This Agreement is incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein, and is made a part hereof.
