

ORDINANCE NO. 721

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.192
PROVIDING FOR THE RENEWAL OF PLUMBER'S LICENSES

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Penn Township Board of Commissioners, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 192 is amended as follows:

Section 1-14, G, (1) (being, Section 104-7 of the Penn Township Code) which now reads:

“Master plumbers and journeymen plumbers shall renew their certificates annually by application to the Township Clerk. Failure to renew a certificate before February 1 shall be construed as allowing the license to lapse, in which case the appropriate license may be renewed within sixty (60) days at half the original license fee. After a lapse of sixty (60) days, reexamination will be required at the full fee.”

Is hereby amended to read:

“Master plumbers and journeyman plumbers shall renew their certificates by application to the Township Secretary. Failure to renew a certificate before January 15th shall be construed as allowing the license to lapse, in which case plumbing permit applications submitted by the plumber shall be denied. The Township may recognize a valid plumbing license issued by a municipality with which Penn Township has a reciprocity agreement or understanding. A lapsed license may be renewed by March 15th at the standard renewal fee rate. After March 15th, re-examination and re-certification of the plumber shall be required. Fees for licenses and testing/certification shall be as set by Resolution, from time to time, by the Penn Township Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 2. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

The article adopted shall be deemed to be incorporated into the Penn Township Code so that reference shall be understood and intended to include such changes.


