

ORDINANCE NO. 640

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 465 WHICH ESTABLISHES AND REGULATES A POLICE PENSION FUND ALONG WITH ADDITIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PENN TOWNSHIP POLICE FORCE ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT OF MAY 29, 1956, P.L. 1804, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING THE DATE WHEN AN OFFICER BECOMES A PARTICIPANT IN THE POLICE PENSION FUND.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Penn Township Board of Commissioners, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same that Ordinance No. 465 shall be amended as follows:

SECTION AMENDMENTS

Subsection 4. Members

Shall be amended to read:

“Each police officer shall be considered a participant in the police pension fund on his first day of continuous full time employment subsequent to confirmation of his employment by the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 2. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid, said invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective on the date that the Penn Township Patrolman's Association executes the Addendum to the Collective Bargaining Agreement amending Article


19 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement accepting this Ordinance No. 640 as amending the retirement benefits and rights provided pursuant to Ordinance 465.
