

ORDINANCE NO. 654

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN,
YORK COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING
PREVIOUS FIREFIGHTERS PENSION PLAN
DOCUMENT AND ADOPTING A NEW PENSION
PLAN DOCUMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Authority of Penn Township, York
County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by the Board of Commissioners of Penn
Township, it is hereby Ordained and Enacted, as follows:

SECTION 1. ESTABLHMENT

This Ordinance establishes a new retirement plan for the firefighter employees
of Penn Township the adoption of the Penn Township Firefighters Pension Plan
Document effective January 1, 2007.

SECTION 2. EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS


This Ordinance establishes an annual employer contribution equivalent to
10% of current year participation payroll plus any forfeitures.

SECTION 3. SAVINGS PROVISION


In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this

remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of the Retirement plan, it being
the intent of the Township that such remainder shall be remain in full force and
effect.
