RESOLUTION NO. 1010

ADOPTING POLICES OF THE PENN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the safety and security of the residents of Penn Township are of paramount importance to the Penn Township Board of Commissioners (the “Board”); and

WHEREAS, the Penn Township Police Department has developed comprehensive polices and procedures aimed at maintaining public safety, upholding the law, and fostering positive community relations; and

WHEREAS, the Penn Township Police Department’s policies are designed to ensure the fair and equitable treatment of all individuals, regardless of their background, race, ethnicity, gender, religion, or socio-economic status; and

WHEREAS, the Penn Township Police Department has engaged in a thorough review and revision of its policies to align with current best practices and legal standards in law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Board is committed to maintaining transparency, accountability, and continuous improvement within the Penn Township Police Department;

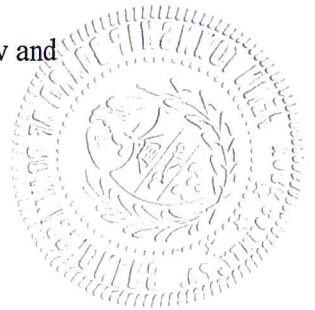
NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and approved as follows:

Section 1: Adoption of Policies. The Board hereby adopts the policies and procedures of the Penn Township Police Department, as presented in the official policy manual as presented on August 21, 2023. These policies shall guide the actions, conduct, and interactions of all members of the Penn Township Police Department in carrying out their duties to serve and protect the residents of Penn Township.

Section 2: Commitment to Community Relations. The Board emphasizes the importance of positive community relations between the Penn Township Police Department and the residents of Penn Township. The adopted policies reflect the commitment to building trust, fostering collaboration, and promoting open communication between law enforcement and the community.

Section 3: Ongoing Review and Improvement. The Penn Township Police Department is directed to conduct regular reviews of its policies to ensure alignment with evolving best practices, legal requirements, and community expectations. The Board encourages a continuous improvement process that involves seeking input from stakeholders, including community members, experts, and law enforcement professionals.

Section 4: Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
