A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY WITH A VALUE OF LESS THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS

WHEREAS, the Penn Township Board of Commissioners (the "Board") recognizes that it is in the best interest of the Township to dispose of unneeded surplus and obsolete personal property in order to provide for the efficient and effective management of the Township; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 1501 II of the First Class Township Code, the Board has the authority to authorize the sale of surplus personal property, either individual lots or lots of items, of an estimated fair market value of less than one thousand dollars without proceeding to a public sale or bid; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate this goal, the Board desires to authorize the sale of an obsolete vehicle for scrap metal that has a value of less than one thousand dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PENN TOWNSHIP, that the Township is hereby authorized to sell a 1993 Chevy Van/Box truck for scrap given that its estimated value is less than one thousand dollars.
