

RESOLUTION NO. 687

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE TAPPING FEE TO INCLUDE THE ADDITION OF A REIMBURSEMENT COMPONENT FOR FUTURE CONNECTIONS TO THE WHISPERING RUN/HIGH POINT NORTH/MAITLAND INVESTMENT/MARTIN'S RIDGE SEWER INTERCEPTOR (AKA PLUM CREEK).

WHEREAS, Act 57 of 2003 (hereafter referred to as the "Act"), which amends the PA Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, allows for the imposition of fees on property owners who connect to the Township's sanitary sewer system, and

WHEREAS, the Act provides for the imposition of separate fees to allow for recovery of specific capital costs, and

WHEREAS, the Act further provides for the additional assessment of a reimbursement component payable to the person at whose expense sewer extensions are constructed, and

WHEREAS, a consortium of developers has constructed and dedicated a sanitary sewer extension to the Township of Penn by a deed recorded on February 22, 2008 in deed book 1949 page 2260, and


WHEREAS, the Township is desirous of amending its Tapping Fee to include said reimbursement component for future connections to the Plum Creek Interceptor through manhole 8-96.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that the Taping Fee for connections through Manhole 8-96 shall be set at \$2,590 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU), which includes \$512/EDU representing the Capacity part and \$518/EDU which represents the Collection part, and \$1,560/EDU which represents the Plum Creek Reimbursement Part.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this fee shall be incorporated into the Fee Schedule for Permits and Services provided by Penn Township.
