

RESOLUTION #697
Adopting the
York County Hazard Mitigation Plan

Whereas, Penn Township, York County, recognizes the threat that natural and man made hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, Penn Township participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Hazard Mitigation Plan, and finds that it meets the approval of Penn Township contingent upon this official adoption;

Therefore, be it resolved that Penn Township adopts the York County Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official planning instrument subject to implementation by participating governments and entities; and

Be it further resolved that Penn Township will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency Region III.
