

RESOLUTION NO. 791

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE RATE OF PAY FOR THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE REMAINDER OF 2012 AND FOR THE YEAR 2013.

WHEREAS, JAMES W. LAUGHLIN, has been selected to the vacant position of Chief of Police, effective September 1, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the yearly salary for the position of Chief of Police shall be set at \$95,000 annually for 2012 and 2013.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that New Year's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, the Friday following Thanksgiving, the last working day before Christmas, Christmas Day and the last working day before New Year's Day shall be designated as paid holidays with the Police Chief being compensated for eight (8) hours at the normal straight time rate. In addition to the holidays, the Police Chief shall have four (4) paid personal holidays.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police shall be entitled to all other benefits received by full-time management personnel as specified in Resolution No. 772.


