RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PENN TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter "the Township").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the Township adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the Township, and

WHEREAS, the Township has prepared an "Act 537 Plan Update" which provides for sewage facilities in PENN Township, and

The alternatives of choice to be implemented include pump station consolidation, an extension of the sanitary sewer system to the Oak Hills, Hershey Heights and Broadway areas, and the onlot system disposal (OLDS) Sewage Management Program


WHEREAS, the Township finds that the Plan Update described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Penn Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the Township, the above referenced Plan Update. The Township hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).


