

ULTRAVIOLET DISINFECTION SYSTEM UPGRADE

The PENN TOWNSHIP Board of Commissioners will receive sealed proposals online via PennBid for the ULTRAVIOLET DISINFECTION SYSTEM UPGRADE Project, Contract 1 – General Construction, Contract 2 – Electrical Construction in accordance with the Contract Documents. Sealed bids may be submitted and updated online via the PennBid Program until 2:00 PM on November 9, 2018. Bids will be opened and read aloud shortly thereafter at the Penn Township Building, 20 Wayne Avenue, Hanover, PA 17331.

The work includes all material, labor, and equipment necessary for construction of a new UV facility and the demolition of specific existing chlorine contact facility as shown on the drawings and as specified. The project is located at 1020 Wilson Avenue, Hanover, PA 17331.
